Building Stock Damage

- · Hazus estimates that about 2,041 buildings will be at least moderately damaged
- There are an estimated 66 buildings that will be completely destroyed.

WATCH VS. WARNING

- A watch is issued when weather conditions are <u>favorable</u> for the development of tornadoes in and close to the watch area. Like a Tornado Watch...
- A warning is issued when the threat is occurring. A Tornado Warning is issued when a funnel cloud or tornado is spotted OR by radar signature.
