

Poinciana Bus Transportation

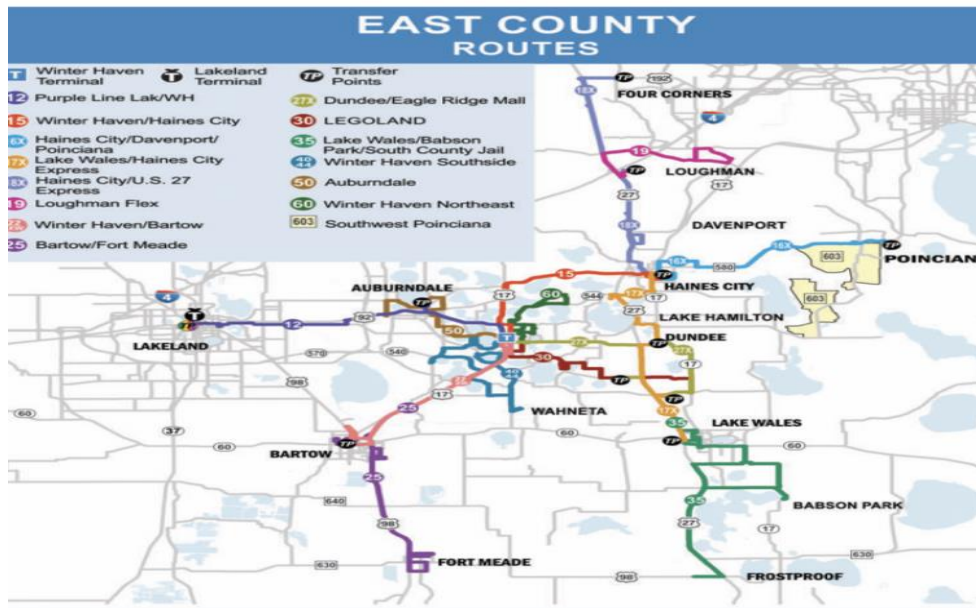


Poinciana is an unincorporated community split between Polk and Osceola Counties. Initially the only bus service provided to Poinciana was through Lynx on the Osceola side. Several years ago Polk County recognized the need for bus service in all the Polk Poinciana Villages including Solivita. So Polk County paid Lynx to extend bus service to the Polk Poinciana villages. The busses carried Lynx Logo but were paid for by Polk county.

Recently Polk County decided they could offer better service to Poinciana residents by adding their own Citrus Connection busses to handle the services to the Polk Poinciana villages and not use the Lynx busses. The two existing bus routes that will change are the 603 pickup bus services to villages 3,7 and 8 plus the 416 bus connection to Haines city



The 603 route will remain the same with the exact same service. The only difference will be that it must be scheduled by calling Citrus Connection at 855-765-5287 to schedule pickups. The old 416 bus route now is called the 16X route that offers regular scheduled busses between Poinciana Walmart and Haines City.
