Osceola County invites you to a public information meeting regarding the Marigold Avenue Safety Improvements Project on Thursday, August 4, 2022. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic flow and help encourage safer driving speeds.

Osceola County is recommending the addition of single-lane modern roundabouts at Peabody Road, Laurel Avenue, and San Lorenzo Road. A northbound left-turn lane is recommended at San Miguel Road. Design of this project began earlier this year. This hybrid public meeting will give the community an opportunity to learn about the project and provide feedback. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2025. The County is designing and constructing this project using safety funds from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

The County is offering three ways to participate in the meeting. All participants will receive the same information regardless of which option they choose.

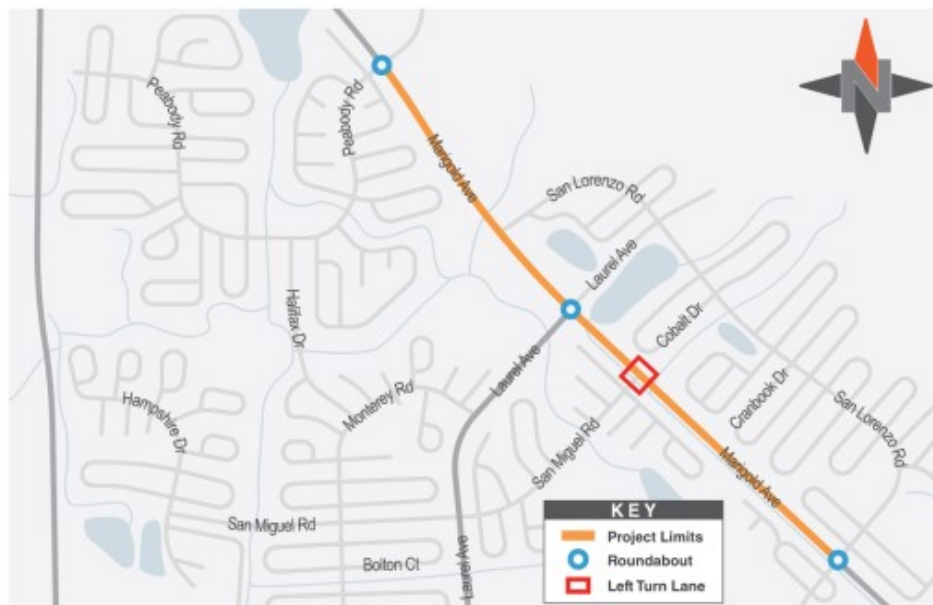
